**Focus** – Speaking at the County Council meeting, Mr Carter said that from 3 June 2019, the county's 18 Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRCs) across Kent will continue to receive household waste, with a modest charge for the disposal of soil, rubble, hardcore and plasterboard. 'The income derived will help KCC further improve our Household Waste Recycling Centres and indeed expand them'. Announcing that KCC will open and fund an additional Household Waste Recycling Centre in Allington – within 12 to 15 months serving the T&M area taking pressure off Cuxton site.
