**Focus** –RIS3 has 6 key objectives.  
*Improving safety for all, Network Performance, Growing the Economy, Managing and Planning the Strategic Road Network for the future, Improved Environmental Outcomes and Technology Enabled Network.* The Infrastructure Act 2015 requires the Government to set a road investment strategy for National Highways. The current strategy will expire on 31 March 2025 and NH now need to start work to develop the next one, RIS3, which will cover 1 April 2025 to 31 March 2030. An important first stage in this process is to gather evidence about what people want from the SRN and National Highways so NH can develop the strategic objectives for RIS3.
