Focus – *The house of commons is 650 MP Seats. In 1950 we had 625 and in 1997 there were 659. It reduced to 646 in 2005 and then increased to 650 in 2010. A review in 2023 proposed new boundary changes and for planned implementation at the 2024 General Election. Each constituency having between 69,724 and 77,062 people. We are to be known as ‘Tonbridge County Constituency’ with our boundary stretching from Hartley in the north to Edenbridge in the south with central zones including Borough Green and Tonbridge Town.
