Focus – *We all need to be more water efficient. This plan normally looks 25 years into the future, however because the south east faces a number of unique challenges, including changing weather patterns and considerable population growth, they have taken the decision to look forward 60 years to 2080. The plan indicates a need for 294.2 million litres of additional water every day by 2080 to meet demand. South East Water are reducing the amount of lost water through leaks, metered to date 80% of customers and helping reduce tap water demand.*
