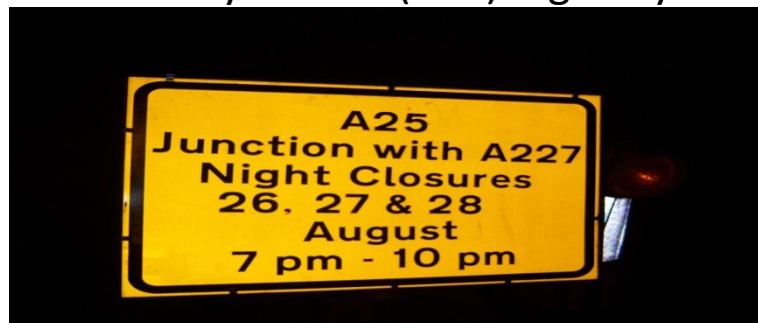
J5 Slips – Highways Agency Scheme



Focus - West Kent is eaten alive by passing through traffic from lack of M25 J5 Slip roads at Sevenoaks to connect the A21 to M26. 18,000 vehicles per day pound the A25 and 12,000 use the A227. Due to no J5 Slip roads, traffic is forced to go through our villages increasing the 'wear and tear' on our roads which we as taxpayers then have to pay via our Council Tax to be repaired. The Borough Green road works are a classic example. However, we are also having a new roundabout and traffic calming as highway improvements. J5 Slips will be a major win for us. Joshua 3:5
