Focus – *Red Ensigns can be flown on a Civic / Public / historic / landmark building or prominent flagpole on Sunday 3rd September 2017. The Red Ensign may be freely flown ashore anywhere in the UK at any time of year. For example it is permissible for it to be flown from Friday 1st to Monday 4th September 2017. You can organise a flag – hoisting ceremony involving local dignitaries and VIPs. Merchant Navy veteran's, Sea Cadets, Etc. It does not have to be on Merchant Navy Day. The Merchant Navy Memorial in London will hold an event on 3rd September attended by HRH The Earl of Wessex. Job 1*
